

FAQ's

How much does league bowling cost?

Seniors and Youth Leagues pay \$13.01 per week [including shoes], & Adult Leagues pay \$20.64 per week, shoes not included

How long are League Seasons?

Our Fall/Winter leagues run from September-April, and our Spring/Summer leagues run from May-August.

How often does League Bowling Happen?

Our Senior Leagues play on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 1:00pm [all separate leagues].

Adult Leagues play Mondays at 6:00pm/8:30pm, Tuesdays at 5:00pm/7:30pm, Wednesdays at 7:30pm, & Thursdays at 6:15pm [all separate leagues].

Our Youth league plays on Saturdays at 9:15am. (Free coaching/Practice at 8:15am)

How long does it take to play?

Each League takes about 2 and a half hours to play each week.

How Does League Bowling Work?

All of our leagues are handicapped based [similar to a golf handicap], so the better bowler you are, the lower your handicap is and vice versa.

League bowlers play on teams of 3 - 5 people [same bowlers every week] but play a different team each week. There are points involved based on your team scores [with a combined team handicap] so that it's fair across the league.

What is a guaranteed league?

A guaranteed league means that each week a spot is held for you, and that your weekly lineage fees are owed each week even if you don't show up.

What if I can't make it one week?

We offer options such as prebowling or finding a spare.

Prebowling is when you come in in advance of the date you will miss, pay your weekly fees to our Front Desk and bowl your 3 games in advance. These scores are recorded and used on the date you specify as if you were here.

Sparing is when you ask a friend or family member to bowl in place of you on the day you will miss. Some teams have an extra team member they are familiar with to help sub it when someone on the team can't make it.

What other costs are involved?

All leagues collect Prize Money from each league member. This ranges from \$3-\$4 per person, per week and at the end of the season, all monies get returned to the league bowlers based on their team and individual results. This gets collected by the league executives and NOT Langford Lanes.

There is a one time registration fee to Langford Lanes at the beginning of the Fall/Winter season. \$11.03 per senior & youth league bowler, and \$27.10 per adult league bowler

Sanctioned leagues have a one-time registration fee of \$35.00 per bowler which is collected by the league executives on behalf of the Canadian TenPin Federation.

What is a sanctioned league?

Sanctioned leagues are sanctioned by the Canadian TenPin Federation, and allows their league members to participate in bowling tournaments here at Langford Lanes, British Columbia and across Canada.

Sanctioned league bowlers are also eligible to win badges and awards based on their scores throughout the season.

What skill level do leagues require?

There is absolutely no experience necessary when it comes to league bowling. We have all sorts of skill levels throughout our leagues and while some individually can be more competitive, there are lots of individuals who come just to have fun and bowl and don't care about the scores.

What if I want to get my own ball and shoes?

We do offer Bowling Ball and Shoe sales here at Langford Lanes. We have a display case that has examples of bowling shoes, balls and bags but can order based on your needs and requirements. Please see Selena to inquire!

Are there any discounts for League Members?

Each season a league ID card is given out to league members identifying them as staff members. We offer a league bowling rate of \$33.33/lane/hour or \$6.77/games [regular rates vary between \$48 and \$52/lane/hour]. League bowling rates are available Monday through Friday from 10:00am-5:00pm and Sundays from 9:00am-11:00am.

League members are also able to receive 5% off of food and non alcoholic beverages anytime.
